

Bibliography for the Art of Ancient Iran

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This bibliography had been intended to acquaint readers of the German paperbound edition of my book, *The Art of Ancient Iran*, which was to appear as an unrevised reprint in the summer of 1977, with the important literature on the art of Iran, particularly with the works which had appeared since 1963. Owing to a misunderstanding, the bibliography was not printed and only a private edition of 100 copies will be run off. Hence the editors of *JANES* decided to include the bibliography in the present issue as a service to persons interested in ancient Iran.

The bibliography consists of a *selection* of books, articles, and even reviews which contain valuable information on the art of Iran. Archaeological reports which contain essential stratigraphic and chronological data are also included. A bibliography can never be up to date because of the gap in time between the completion of the manuscript and its publication.

In the compilation of this bibliography, I have had the help of Prudence O. Harper, Holly Pittman, Barbara A. Porter and Mary Jane Sheridan.
